- 4. Enumerate the fundamental principles of Human Resource Management (HRM).
- 5. List the various sources of recruitment.
- 6. While drafting the guidelines for promotion, which factors are to be considered?
- 7. How is the size of inventory decided in a pharmacy?

- 8. Outline the space requirements for laundry services in a hospital. Give the importance of stain removal.
- 9. State the fire safety precautions to be followed in a hospital.
- 10. How is linen classified in hospitals? Give the norms for Linen per Bed.

11. (a) Discuss the guiding principles in hospital planning with relevant examples. What is the role of a hospital architect? Give the norms for bed planning.

- 12. (a) State the need for human resource inventory planning. Discuss the various aspects of manpower planning.

- 13. (a) Elaborate the frame of work involved in the process of employee recruitment and selection in various departments of a hospital. Identify the challenges faced in each stage.
